

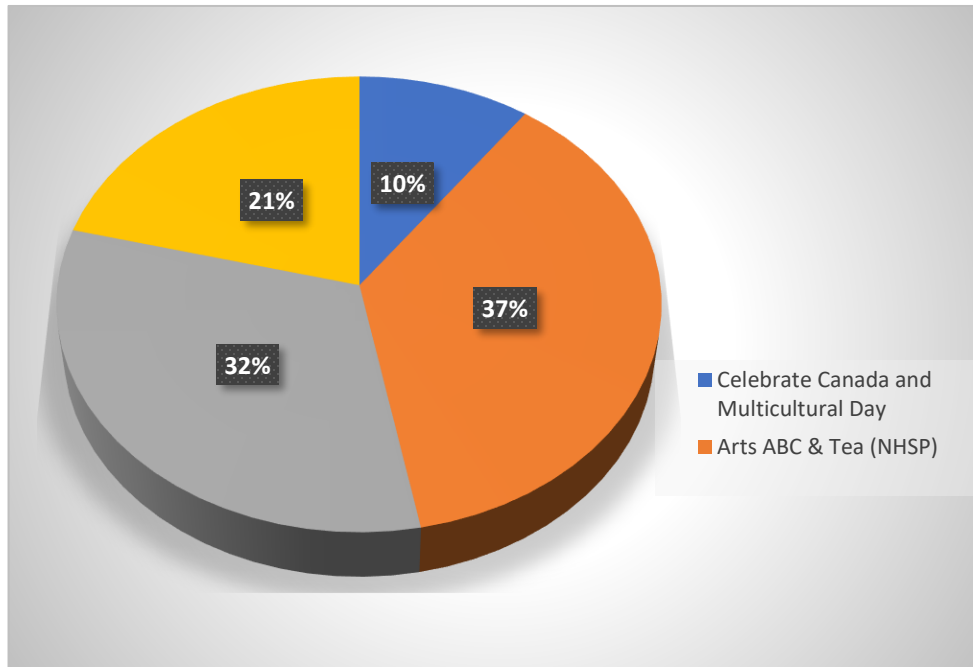

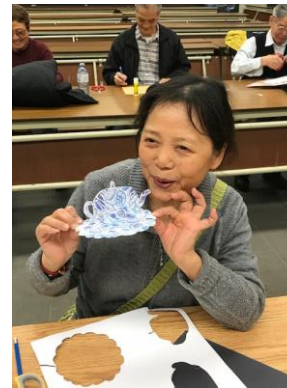


ARTS ABC & TEA
